General Information

The 47th European Study Group with Industry will take place in Denmark and will be hosted by the University of Southern Denmark at a conference center in the Sønderborg area from August 24 until August 29, 2003. The meeting is a premier European industrial and engineering mathematics problem-solving conference. Previous conferences in Denmark took place in Copenhagen and Odense. For the first time, the conference will take place in the Sønderborg area. A large number of high-technological companies create growth and dynamics in the area and make the region one of the most important centers for information technology, telecommunication and electronic in Denmark. Sønderborg is a port, an industrial and commercial center, and a seaside resort. It is a city where the historic past meets the future. Access to Sønderborg is easy whether you travel by car, train or airplane.

Format of the meeting

The meeting will follow the format of previous ESGI meetings. Companies will present their problems on Monday morning, August 25, 2003. Each such problem will be taken up by a group of participants who, together with the company representative, will work toward the problem solution until Thursday afternoon, August 28. On August 29, 2003 a plenary session will be held to present the results from each of the problem groups. A final report on the results of all groups will be published in the ESGI47 Proceedings after the conference and will be sent to all participants.

Mathematics for Industry Workshop

The meeting will feature an embedded workshop to be held on Tuesday afternoon, August 26, 2003. Lectures will be given by distinguished international researchers.

Registration and further information

Industrialists: We seek to attract novel industrial and technological problems. Companies that are interested in the possibility of presenting a problem should contact us at the address given below. There is a problem presentation fee of DKK 15,000. This fee entitles one industrial participant for accommodation with full board. For other participants from industry the registration fee is DKK 5,000 (accommodation and full board inclusive). At the majority of cases the work done at ESGI meetings provide a sufficient material for the company to complete the solution process in-house. In addition, the ESGI will provide opportunities for additional consulting and collaboration between industrial and academic participants after the meeting.

Individual academic participants: There will be no registration fee for the first 30 individual academic participants. They will be offered free accommodation with full board on the first-come first-served basis. For other academic participants there will be a registration fee of DKK 500.
